Baby monitor setup and use:

- Choose a location for the baby unit that will provide the best view of your baby in their crib.
- Place the baby unit on a flat surface, such as a dresser, desk, shelf or wall
 mount the unit securely with the wall mount bracket provided in the pack.
- NEVER place the baby unit or cords in the crib or within reach of the baby (the unit and cords should be more than 3 feet away).

WARNING

This Smart Video Baby Monitor is compliant with all relevant standards regarding electromagnetic fields and is, when handled as described in the User Guide, safe to use. Therefore, always read the instructions in this User Guide carefully before using the device.

- Adult assembly is required. Keep small parts away from children when assembling.
- This product is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with it.
- This baby monitor is not a substitute for responsible adult supervision.
- · Keep this User Guide for future reference.
- Do not place the baby (camera) unit or cords in the crib or within reach of the baby (the unit and cords should be more than 3 feet away).
- · Keep the cords out of reach of children.
- Do not cover the baby monitor with a towel, blanket, or other item that will stop air circulation.
- Never use extension cords with power adapters. Only use the power adapters provided.
- Test this monitor and all its functions so that you are familiar with it prior to actual use
- Do not use the baby monitor near water or allow water or other foreign substances to enter the power port or adapter.
- · Do not place the Baby Monitor near a heat source.
- Only use the chargers and power adapters provided. Do not use other chargers or power adapters as this may damage the device and battery packs.
- · Do not touch the plug contacts with sharp or metal objects.
- The unit should be set up and used so that parts of the user's body other than the hands are maintained at a distance of approximately 8 inches (20 cm) or more.

Thank you for purchasing your new Smart Nursery product. Now you can see and hear your baby sleeping in another room or you can monitor your older children in their playroom.

Important

To use your baby and parent units together, you must be able to establish a radio link between them, and the range will be affected by environmental conditions.

Any large metal object, like a refrigerator, a mirror, a filing cabinet, a metallic door or reinforced concrete between the baby and parent units may block the radio signal.

The signal strength may also be reduced by other solid structures, like walls, or by radio or electrical equipment, such as TVs, computers, cordless or mobile phones, fluorescent lights or dimmer switches.

Other 2.4 GHz products, such as wireless networks (Wi-Fi* routers), Bluetooth™ systems, microwave ovens or other baby monitors, may cause interference with this product, so keep the baby monitor at least 5 ft (1.5 m) away from these types of products, or switch them off if they appear to be causing interference.

If the signal is weak, try moving the parent and/or the baby unit(s) to different positions in rooms.



1. Getting started

Location

Important

Do not place your VM45 CONNECT, VM45-2 CONNECT, VM45-3 CONNECT or VM45-4 CONNECT in the bathroom or other humid areas.

Place your units within reach of the AC power outlet and wall socket. The socket-outlet should be installed near the equipment and should be easily accessible.

Setting up


Important

The baby (camera) unit must be plugged into the wall socket at all times. Use only the AC power adapter supplied with the product.

Connecting and charging

Baby unit

You will need to carry out this process for the single or multi baby (camera) units.




- Plug the DC round socket adapter into the DC jack on the rear of the baby (camera) unit and plug the other end of the AC adapter into the AC power outlet.
- Switch on the AC power (if your AC power outlet has a switch). The baby (camera) unit will turn on and its power indicator will light up blue and start flashing red after 30 seconds if the parent unit has not been powered on.

Parent unit

A rechargeable battery is already pre-installed inside the parent unit. When fully charged, you can move the parent unit without losing the connnection or picture from the baby (camera) unit. When charging the battery for the first time, allow it to charge continuously for at least 16 hours. Subsequent charging typically takes about 8 to 10 hours per day. A fully charged battery should provide up to 15 hours of usage time.

Important

Warning! Use only the approved rechargeable Lithium battery (2450mAh) supplied with your **VM45 CONNECT**.



- Plug the DC round socket adapter into the power jack on the side of the parent unit and plug the other end into the wall socket.
- 2. Switch on the AC power (if your AC power outlet has a switch).
- When the parent unit is fully charged, will appear steadily on the screen display.

Battery low warning

If __ on the screen flashes and an alert tone is heard, it means the battery level is low and needs recharging.

When charging, will scroll on the display.

Battery performance

In ideal conditions, fully charged batteries should provide up to 9 hours of usage time when the screen is on and up to 15 hours usage time when the screen is off


The charge capacity of the rechargeable battery will reduce with time as it wears out, giving the parent unit less usage / standby time. Eventually it will need to be replaced.


Batteries and the parent unit may become warm during charging. This is normal.

Your VM45 CONNECT is now ready for use.

2. Getting to know your baby monitor

Overview of your baby unit (camera)





A Light sensor

It detects a low level of ambient light to activate night vision mode.

B Infrared LEDs

There are 8 infrared LEDs around the camera which capture clear images in the dark. They turn on automatically when the light sensor detects a low level of ambient light.

C Camera

D Power / Linking LED indicator

It lights up in blue when the parent unit is powered on and linked to the baby (camera) unit.

It flashes red when the camera unit is not connected to either the parent unit or Wi-Fi routers.

It turns off automatically during night mode.

E Microphone

It picks up sound from the baby.

Note: Make sure you remove any cover or protective tape from it.

F Speaker

G Antenna

H Pair button

Press and hold to pair with the parent unit or the Motorola Nursery app.


I Power jack

J Temperature sensor

K Desk stand

Overview of your parent unit





A LCD display

B Indicators (Battery, Power, Sound Level or Pairing)

Battery and power: it lights up green when powered on; it lights up red when battery low, purple when battery charging and blue when fully charged.

Sound level (green, orange, red, red): the louder the detected sound, the more LEDs will light up.

Pairing: It flashes green rapidly when in pairing mode.

C Main menu

Press to enter/exit the main menu.

D OK/₽

When in a menu, press to select an item or save a setting. When in view mode, press to show navigation arrows.

E Direction control key panel

- When in a menu, press to scroll up.
 Press to increase the speaker volume.
- When in a menu, press to scroll down.
 Press to decrease the speaker volume.
- When in a menu, press to scroll left.
 Press to decrease the brightness in camera viewing mode.
- When in a menu, press to scroll right.
 Press to increase the brightness in camera viewing mode.

F Talk back 🛡

Press and hold to talk to the baby unit.

G Power on/off ()

Press to turn the display on or off. Press and hold to turn the parent unit on or off.

H Power jack

Reset hole

Use a small pin to insert into it to perform a system reset and recover the parent unit from a lock-up state.

J Antenna



Registering the baby (camera) unit to the parent unit (Pairing)

The video baby monitor is pre-registered to your parent unit. You do not need to register it again unless the baby (camera) unit loses connection with the parent unit. To re-register your baby (camera) unit, see the following steps.

- 1. Press and the menu bar will pop up.
- 2. Scroll \triangleleft or \triangleright to select Q^{+} to add a camera. Then $Q^{-1}/Q^{-2}/Q^{-3}/Q^{-4}$ will pop up.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a desired camera, then press OK/Q. The parent unit will start searching for the baby (camera) unit and display press PAIR on cam.
- Press and hold the pair button on the rear of the baby (camera) unit until you hear 'Ready for pairing'. When pairing is successful, 'PAIR OK' appears on the screen, then video from the baby (camera) unit will be displayed.



Note

- A baby (camera) unit can be paired only to one parent unit each time. If a baby (camera) unit is currently paired with the parent unit, Q¹/Q²/Q³/Q³
- If a baby unit was previously registered, registering this baby (camera) unit again will erase the previous registration.

Mount the baby (camera) unit

The baby (camera) unit supports both wall mounting and flexible stargrip mounting. At the bottom of the baby unit, there are slots for wall mounting and a screw nut for the flexible stargrip. The mounting screws are not included.



3. Before use

3.1 Intended use

Be aware that this Smart Digital Video Baby Monitor is only intended as an aid. It is not a substitute for responsible and proper adult supervision.

3.2 Setup location

- Do not place the baby (camera) unit or cords in the crib or within reach
 of the baby. The unit and cords should be more than 1 meter (3 feet) away
 from the baby.
- Make sure there is at least 2 meters (6 feet) between the parent and baby (camera) units to avoid audio feedback. If you experience noise interference, move the baby (camera) and parent units further apart.
- Make sure the parent and baby (camera) units are placed at least 1.5 meters (5 feet) away from other electrical equipment.
- If the baby (camera) unit loses connection with the parent unit, a lost link screen will be shown on the parent unit. Move the baby (camera) unit closer to the parent unit to restore the connection.



3.3 Operating range

The video baby monitor has a range of up to 300 metres (1000 feet) outdoors when there is a clear line of sight between the baby (camera) and parent units. Any obstruction between the units will reduce the range significantly.

3.4 Check the microphone and speaker

- Speak into the microphone on the baby (camera) unit. You should be able to hear the sound from the parent's unit.
- Adjust the speaker volume of the parent unit to the desired level when necessary.



Using the video baby monitor 4

4.1 Parent unit main menu

Media playlist: Jullaby, audiobook, personal recording and volume settings.

Alarm: 6/4/2 hours and off.

Screen on time out: 60/30/5 minutes and off.

4.3 Adjust the speaker volume

Press \triangle or ∇ on the parent unit when it is in camera viewing mode. There are 8 levels to choose from.

4.4 Adjust the brightness on the parent unit

Press on the parent unit when it is in camera viewing mode. There are 8 levels to choose from.

4.5 Enable audio media playback

You can play back pre-recorded personal or preloaded audio content (Iullabies, soothing sounds and English audio books) on the baby (camera) unit to soothe the baby. There are 10 preloaded Iullabies/soothing sounds and 10 audio books in the baby (camera) unit.

4.5.1 Lullabies/soothe sounds playback

- 1. Press on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- 2. Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select ♪ then press OK/②. The names of lullables or soothe sounds will be displayed on the screen.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a desired Iullaby or soothe sound, or to stop playing. Then press OK/0. to start/stop playback.

4.5.2 English audio book playback

- 1. Press on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- 2. Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select ↓ then press OK/Q. The names of the audio books will be displayed on the screen.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a desired audio book or stop playing. Then press OK/Q. to start/stop playback.

4.5.3 Pre-recorded personal content playback

You can play back your personal content after recording the audio through the Motorola Nursery App.

- 1. Press on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select № then press OK/Q. The names of your recordings will be displayed on the screen.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a desired recording or stop playing. Then press OK/Q. to start/stop playback.

4.5.4 Adjust the volume level of audio playback

- 1. Press on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select ② then press OK/Q. The volume status bar pops up.
- 3. Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select the volume level There are 3 levels to choose from.

4.6 Set the alarm

You can set alarms on the parent unit to remind you or caregivers of the time to feed the baby, change the baby's diaper or put the baby to bed.

- 1. Press on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- 2. Scroll ◀ or ▶ to select 🔘.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select an alarm: 2H, 4H or 6H (H = hours), or press of to deselect all alarms. Then will appear or disappear on the status bar.
- 4. When the set time is reached, the alarm will beep for about 1 minute. Press any key to stop the alarm.

4.7 Power saving mode

- 1. Press on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- 2. Scroll ◀ or ▶ to select 🖭
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a screen off time: 5', 30' or 60' (' = minutes), or press ⊘ to deselect all alarms.
- 4. When operating on battery power only, the screen will turn off after the preset power saving time limit is reached.

Note

You can still hear the audio when the screen is off. Press any key to wake it up. In addition, the screen will turn on automatically when a sound is detected from the camera unit.

4.8 Zoom the screen

- 1. Press = on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- 2. Scroll ◀ or ▶ to select €.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select X1 or X2 zoom.

4.9 Set the temperature unit

The baby (camera) unit has a temperature sensor that can detect the baby room temperature.

- 1. Press on the parent unit. pops up on the menu bar.
- 2. Scroll ◀ or ▶ to select ▮.
- 3. Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a temperature format: °C or °F.

4.10 Talk back

You can use the Talk Back feature to comfort and reassure your baby. While Talk Back is acti<u>v</u>e, you will not be able to hear your baby.

Press and hold $\underline{\Psi}$ on the parent unit to talk to your baby through the parent unit's microphone.

4.11 Use the camera

4.11.1 Pair or add a camera with the parent unit

See 'Registering the baby (camera) unit to the parent unit (Pairing)' in Section 2.

4.11.2 View a camera

You can access the cameras through the menu bar by following the steps below.

- Press = and the menu bar will pop up.
- 2. Scroll or to select 0° . Then $0^{1}/0^{2}/0^{3}/0^{4}$ will pop up.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a desired camera. Then press OK/@. to view the picture from that camera.

Note

You can only view the camera already registered in the parent unit.

4.11.3 Remove a camera

- 1. Press and the menu bar will pop up.
- 2. Scroll \triangleleft or \triangleright to select \bigcirc . Then \bigcirc 1/ \bigcirc 2/ \bigcirc 3/ \bigcirc 4 will pop up.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select a desired camera to remove it from registration, then press OK/0.
- 4. Press ∇ to select \mathbf{X} . Then press \mathbf{OK}/\mathbf{Q} to confirm.

Note

You cannot remove the camera if it is the only registered camera in the parent unit.

4.11.4 Use the patrol mode

This function is available if you have more than one baby (camera) unit.

- 1. Press and the menu bar will pop up.
- Scroll

 ✓ or

 ✓ to select

 ✓.
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select ♀ or press OK/♀ to confirm. The screen will start displaying images from different registered cameras.

4.12 View multiple cameras on screen

If you have more than one baby (camera) unit, you can turn on the split screen function.

- 1. Press and the menu bar will pop up.
- 2. Scroll ◀ or ▶ to select ♀ .
- Scroll ▲ or ▼ to select ☐ press OK/Q to confirm. Images from different registered cameras will be displayed on the screen at the same time.

4.13 Messages and alerts

This feature helps you stay informed about your baby monitor's status, Make sure you check the messages and alerts to see if there's anything that requires your attention, so as to ensure your baby monitor is working properly.

- 1. Press = and the menu bar will pop up.
- 2. Scroll \triangleleft or \triangleright to select \boxtimes , press OK/Q to view the notifications.


5.1 Minimum System Requirements

Android™ System: Version 7.0 or above

iPhone® iOS: Version 11.0 or above

High Speed (Wi-Fi*) Internet: At least 0.6 Mbps upload bandwidth per camera (you can test your internet speed on this site: http://www.speedtest.net).

5.2 Connect to Wi-Fi® and use the Nursery App



When a user tries to access the Wi-Fi* camera (baby unit), our server authenticates the user's identity and permits access to the Wi-Fi* camera (baby unit).

Note

You can only set up through a compatible smartphone but not through a PC.

5.3 Set up the camera

Connect the Wi-Fi* camera (baby unit) to the power adapter, then plug into the wall socket. The camera must be within range of the Wi-Fi* router with which you want to connect. Make sure the password of the router is available for entering during the in-app setup process.

The following table shows the meanings of different LED connection status.

5.3.1 Set up user account and camera on your devices

You will need:

- Wi-Fi® camera (baby unit)
- · Power adapter for the camera
- Device with Android™ system version 7.0 or above, or iPhone® with iOS version 11.0 or above
- Wi-Fi® router works at 2.4 GHz

5.3.2 Connect the Camera

- Switch off the parent unit before connecting the camera (baby unit) to Wi-Fi*.
- Connect the power adapter to the power outlet and insert the plug into the power socket on the back of the camera (baby unit). The camera turns on.

5.3.3 Download the App

 Scan the QR code with your smart device and download the Motorola Nursery App from App Store for iOS devices or from Google Play™ Store for Android™ devices.







Install the App on your device.

5.3.4 Sign up or log in to the App

- 1. Ensure that your smart device is connected to your Wi-Fi® router.
- 2. Follow the on-screen instructions to run and sign up or log in to the APP.

5.3.5 Add a camera to your account

- 1. Log in to the App.
- 2. Tap **Devices**, and then tap + on the device screen to add a new camera.
- 3. Tap (your baby monitor model's name) to add the new camera.
- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions to add the new camera.

5.4 Reset the camera

You will need to reset your camera if you relocate your camera from one router to another.

- Press and hold the pair button on the camera for about 15 seconds. You
 will first hear the voice prompt 'Ready for pairing'. Do not release it until you
 hear a beep. Within 3 seconds after the beep, short press it twice and you
 will hear the voice prompt 'Reset Camera'. The camera has now been reset
 successfully. Then you can release the button. Wait for one minute to make
 sure the reset is fully complete.
- 2. Follow the section 5.3.5 to add the camera again.

6 Help

No display

- Try recharging the battery pack.
- Reset the parent and baby (camera) units. Unplug both units from the wall socket, then plug them back in.
- Check if the parent/baby (camera) unit is powered on.
- When operating on battery power only, the parent unit display will turn off after the preset power saving time limit is reached.

The baby (camera) unit has lost its link with the parent unit.

- The baby (camera) unit is too far away and may be out of range. Move the
 it closer to the parent unit.
- Flip out the antenna on the parent unit.
- Try placing the parent unit or the baby (camera) unit at different location as they may be in the wireless dead zone where they have difficulty linking together.
- Disconnect both the parent and baby (camera) units from the power outlet.
 Wait for about 15 seconds and reconnect them. Allow up to one minute for the parent and baby (camera) units to synchronize.

Noise interference on your parent unit

- Make sure there is at least (2 meters) 6 feet between the parent and baby (camera) units to avoid audio feedback.
- The baby (camera) unit is too far away and may be out of range. Move it closer to the parent unit.
- Make sure the parent and baby (camera) units are not placed near other electrical equipment, such as a television, computer or cordless/mobile telephone. Move the parent and baby (camera) units 1.5 meters (5 feet) away from other electrical equipment.
- Use of other 2.4 GHz products, such as wireless networks (Wi- Fi* routers), Bluetooth™ systems, or microwave ovens, may cause interference with this product.
- If the signal is weak, try moving the parent and/or baby (camera) units to different positions in rooms.

Noise interference on your device

- To avoid background noise or echoes, ensure there is enough distance between your device and the baby (camera) unit.
- Use of other 2.4 GHz products, such as Bluetooth™ systems or microwave ovens, may cause interference with this product. Keep the parent and baby (camera) units at least 1.5 meters (5 feet) away from these types of products, or switch them off if they appear to be causing interference.

Lost connection to your smart device

Check your Wi-Fi* settings and reconnect your Wi-Fi* if necessary. Ensure
the baby (camera) unit is switched on. Wait for a few minutes for the baby
(camera) unit to connect with the Wi-Fi* system.

System reset

- When problems cannot be fixed based on the above guides, you can try
 to do a system reset. Note that after system reset, you will need to do the
 pairing to the app again.
- System reset for the parent unit: right under the power jack on the parent unit, there is a small hole. Use a small pin to insert and press into it. The parent unit will go through a system reset.
- Press and hold the pair button on the camera for about 15 seconds. You
 will first hear the voice prompt 'Ready for pairing'. Do not release it until you
 hear a beep. Within 3 seconds after the beep, short press it twice and you
 will hear the voice prompt 'Reset Camera'. The camera has now been reset
 successfully.

Two phones view the same camera

Please use the same email address to log in to the app on another phone.
 Then both phones can view the video at the same time.

New Wi-Fi router

- · You will need to pair your camera with your new Wi-Fi router.
 - **IMPORTANT**: The following procedure will delete any video recordings from motion detection. If you want to keep these photos/videos, please save them to your phone before proceeding.
- Before pairing, please do the following:
 - 1. Delete the camera from the app: Tab the video screen, then tab the camera settings icon (which looks like a sun). Scroll down to the bottom of the screen and tab **Delete**.
 - 2. Reset the camera unit: Press and hold the pair button on the camera for about 15 seconds. You will first hear the voice prompt 'Ready for pairing'. Do not release it until you hear a beep. Within 3 seconds after the beep, short press it twice and you will hear the voice prompt 'Reset Camera'. The camera has now been reset successfully. Then you can release the button. Wait for one minute to make sure the reset is fully complete. After this, you can start pairing the camera with your new Wi-Fi router.
