Setting up your Digital Video Baby Monitor

A. Connecting the Power Supply for the Baby Unit



- Insert the DC plug of the power adapter into the DC socket on the back of the Baby Unit.
- Connect the other end of the power adapter to a suitable electrical outlet.
- The baby unit turns on and the power indicator lights up blue.

Only use the supplied power adapter (DC5V/1000mA).





B. Fixing magnetic mount to the wall

- · Mark the position of the screw holes on the wall.
- Install wall anchors (Not provided) suitable for the wall type and mounting screws if needed.
- Fasten the mounting screws (Not provided) to the wall.
- Position the cable behind the base as the picture shows before hooking the base on the wall.

C. Connecting the Power Supply of the Parent Unit



electrical outlet. Only use the enclosed adapter (5VDC/1000mA). A rechargeable battery (Lithium ion battery 2000mAh) inside the Parent Unit allows you to move it without losing the link and picture from the Baby Unit. The battery provides up to 5 hours operation of the Parent Unit. We recommend

charging for at least 16 hours before first use, and when the Parent Unit indicates the battery is low.

D. Desktop Stand of the Parent Unit

- Flip out the stand on the back of the Parent Unit
- We recommend to rotate it by 90 degree to set up the desktop stand.
